

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to CFR.158.24 the City of Garden City (City), owner and operator of the Garden City Regional Airport (Airport), hereby provides public notice of the City's intention to file a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) application with the intent to impose and use the Passenger Facility Charge at the Airport to fund the local share of PFC eligible Airport Improvements. The proposed charge effective date is October 1, 2020 with the estimated expiration date of November 1, 2025.
